

Maison Toulouse Services is equipped with the system for biometric identity cards and passports. To apply for your national identity card and biometric passport, you need to make an appointment.

> CIVIL STATUS FORMALITIES

• REGISTERING A BIRTH

Births must be registered with the registry office of the city hall in the place of birth within five days of the birth of a child. In Toulouse, registering a birth is by appointment only, at the maternity unit where the baby was born:

- Maternity unit, Clinique Ambroise-Paré 387, route de Saint-Simon - 31100 Toulouse
- Maternity unit, Clinique Rive Gauche 49, allées Charles de Fitte - 31300 Toulouse
- Maternity unit, Hôpital Joseph Ducuing 15, rue de Varsovie - 31300 Toulouse
- Maternity unit Paule de Viguier 330, avenue de Grande-Bretagne - 31300 Toulouse

• MAKING A DECLARATION OF RECOGNITION



If the parents are not married, filiation in respect of the child must be established by a deed of recognition.

• ENTERING INTO, AMENDING OR DISSOLVING A PACS (CIVIL SOLIDARITY PACT)

The civil solidarity pact (PACS) is registered at the City Hall by appointment only after validation of the previously-submitted file. It can also be registered with a notary.

To register with the Toulouse registry office, the partners must establish their joint residence in Toulouse.



• GETTING MARRIED IN TOULOUSE

Conditions for getting married in Toulouse:

- one of the future spouses is domiciled there
- one of the future spouses has been continuously resident there for more than one month
- one of the parents of the future spouses has a domicile or residence there.

In all cases, proof of domicile or residence must be provided.

• REGISTERING A DEATH

A death must be reported within 24 hours directly to the registry office of the city hall where the death occurred.

• CHANGING YOUR NAME

Since the Act of 2 March 2022, it has been possible in certain cases to apply for a change of name to take the name of the parent who did not pass on their surname at the time of birth, or to take both names together. For further information, you can go to the registry office or consult the <u>online procedures</u>



ORGANISING A FUNERAL

The organisation of the funeral must be entrusted to a funeral operator (undertaker) authorised by the prefecture.

• ACCOMMODATION CERTIFICATE

The attestation d'accueil or accommodation certificate is for any foreign national (except European, Andorran or Monegasque nationals) wishing to stay in France for a period not exceeding 3 months (90 days) for a private or family visit. If the foreign national needs a visa to come to France, they must enclose the accommodation certificate with their application for a short-stay visa. The following people are exempt from the requirement to have an accommodation certificate:

- holder of a Schengen circulation visa, valid for a minimum of 1 year for several entries,
- holder of a residence permit, to be applied for within 2 months of arrival,
- people on humanitarian or cultural exchange trips, subject to certain conditions,
- persons coming to France for urgent medical reasons or because of the serious illness or funeral of a close relative, subject to conditions.

• ELECTORAL LISTS

If you are in one of the following situations, you can register on the Toulouse electoral roll:

- If you are a European Union national eligible to vote in municipal and European elections
- You are a newcomer and have just moved to Toulouse
- You have moved within the city of Toulouse (a change of district may result in your being assigned to a different polling station)

The following are automatically entered on the electoral roll:

- People who have acquired French nationality (automatic registration has been provided for since 2019)
- Young people who have completed census procedures at the age of 16 are automatically registered when they turn 18.

Please note: if a young person's address changes since they completed their census, they must complete the voluntary registration procedure detailed opposite.



ELECTORAL ROLL REGISTRATION:

• Apply online

A free, easy, secure and continuously accessible online service enables you to register on the electoral roll :



Register online on the electoral roll

To register, you will need a *France Connect* (https://franceconnect.gouv.fr/) username and password and your supporting documents will need to be scanned beforehand.

You can register to vote all year round.

However, except in exceptional circumstances, only registrations made within the statutory deadlines laid down in the Electoral Code will be taken into account for the current election, i.e. by the sixth Friday before the election for registrations made by post or at the City Hall, and by the sixth Wednesday before the election for online registrations.

Supplementary electoral lists

European Union citizens residing in France can choose to register on supplementary electoral lists to vote in municipal and/or European elections.

You can register online, by post or at the Toulouse Services Centre or the local branch of the City Hall.

PLEASE NOTE for applications received by post, the date on which the post is received by the administration will be taken into account.

• Register at the Toulouse Services Centre or the District City Hall

You can do this yourself or through a duly authorised third party (attestation on plain paper) at one of the Toulouse Services Centres or at your local district city hall.

FOR INFORMATION

At the request of the consular authorities and subject to availability, Toulouse City Council provides rooms and electoral equipment for the organisation of elections. If elections are due to be held in your country of origin, please contact your embassy or consulate to check whether a polling station has been set up in Toulouse.



> CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

• BEFORE YOU START THE PROCESS

To carry out any of these procedures, you must have a DUI (Unique Interactive File) in order to:

- Register your child in a nursery
- Enrol your child at school, at the out-of-school hours leisure centre linked to your school, at the school canteen, at the Wednesday after-school care service (for nursery children)
- Register your child for a leisure activity at the Cultural Centres
- Register for a sports activity (children and adults)
- Register your child for a holiday break
- Pay your DUI-related bills

Your DUI number can be found on each of your bills in the top left-hand corner (canteen, nursery, sports activities, leisure activities, etc.).

REMEMBER: If you already have an account on the online procedures portal, **you must link it to your DUI**. In your dashboard, you'll find all the information relating to your Interactive Unique File, which is linked to all your procedures.

EARLY YEARS CHILDCARE

Childcare tailored to your needs

Children aged 0-3 are cared for in a variety of establishments or at home. Regular or occasional childcare is offered to best meet families' varying needs.


- Nursery registration and admission

Registering your child, step by step

When should I register my child?

- From the last trimester of pregnancy;
- or at least six months before the desired entry date.
- First step: submit your application online
- Since December 2023, applications for nursery places have been made online. Prepare and send your application from home and choose a time to make an appointment with an Espace Petite Enfance to finalise your application.





> EDUCATION

• ENROLLING YOUR CHILD AT SCHOOL

The steps to follow to enrol your child(ren) in a state nursery or primary school in Toulouse.

There are 2 stages to registering your child at the school:



- Request <u>online registration</u> with Toulouse City Hall or with assistance from the Toulouse Services Centres or your local branch of the City Hall.
- Make an appointment with the school management once you have received the letter confirming that your child has been assigned to the school.

• CLAÉ AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



The <u>Claé</u> (school-associated leisure centres) offer a range of high-quality activities led by qualified staff. The aim is to offer children the best possible conditions for success at school and in education



• EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES AND INCLUSION



Help with homework, support with schooling, educational success, support for inclusion: there are many schemes in place to strengthen <u>equal</u> <u>opportunities</u>, and support parents and children.

• Welcoming children with disabilities to school

Toulouse City Council is actively involved in the implementation of an inclusive school system that enables every child to enjoy a high-quality education.

• Educational success

The Réussite éducative / Educational success scheme is aimed at children and teenagers aged 2 to 16. Its aim is to give children who do not benefit from a social, family or cultural environment conducive to their success new opportunities. It is set up on the basis of a proposal from the school to the family.

• Workshops and support for schooling

Toulouse City Council offers three afterschool support and guidance schemes: study workshops, free workshops and educational support.

• SCHOOL MEALS AND CANTEEN MENUS

School meals are available to children enrolled in Toulouse City Council state schools.

Your child is about to start middle or high school (collège or lycée): they will be assigned to the public middle or high school in your area, usually the one closest to your home.
