## Chateau d'Eau Gallery

Located at the foot of the Pont-Neuf, the Water Tower was originally built to supply the city's public fountains with water. Saved from demolition in the early 1970s thanks to the dedication of Toulouse photographer Jean Dieuzaide, it became France's first public gallery exclusively devoted to photography in 1974 and since has hosted major exhibitions. You'll be captivated by its charming Toulouse brick architecture and the original water wheels, still in place. Its garden offers a peaceful green haven, perfect for hosting unique and unforgettable events.
