## The Castelet

Located in a monumental and exceptional building designed by architect Jacques-Jean Esquié at the end of the 19th century, this fortress-like structure once served as the administrative wing of the former Saint-Michel prison. Renovated in 2020, it now functions as an interpretation center dedicated to the prison's history.

The cloister-style ambulatory features large windows opening onto the court of honor. Unique in its architecture, this courtyard offers a privileged outdoor space for your events during the warmer months.
